According to Greg McKettrick, RPh of Stanley's, "We didn't sell that amount in the course of 6 years prior to implementing this program. When you introduce something that's an easy product to adopt, it becomes very popular very quickly and you're getting a lot of repeat business."

Recently, Stanley's began sharing the pharmacy's profitable program with other pharmacies around the country. The program leads to impressive results in ED and prostate patients, in part by combining PDE-5 inhibitor medications with a nitrate-rich supplements from Berkeley Life.



NO is produced by most cells in the body. Among other actions, it plays an important role in vasodilation and penile blood flow. However, NO levels fall by 50% after the age of 40 and continue to decline thereafter. A high-fat diet, lack of exercise, and smoking are some of the factors that can significantly impair NO bioavailability.



NO Depletion: Why ED Medications Often Stop Working Over Time

PDE-5 inhibitors are important in prolonging erections but they require adequate NO to work effectively. However, as NO levels decline with age, changes need to be made to the patient's diet or supplementation implemented to address this. Greg has found that replenishing NO levels through the use of a nitrate-rich supplement often supports the effectiveness of these pharmaceuticals.
